Introducing our new award system in 2018

After feedback and consultation with parents at the parent forum in 2017, staff and students, Bradbury Public School is introducing a new award system in 2018.

We are providing you with a visual display to help you understand and monitor the new award system. (on the reverse of this note)

To encourage self- discipline, teachers issue positive responses for safe, respectful and learner behaviours. These are known as "Classroom Buzzies." These buzzies are blue in colour. Students will save these in class until they receive 10 as they can be "cashed in" to their class teacher for a merit award.

10 classroom buzzies= 1 merit award 5 merit awards= 1 school ribbon 3 school ribbons= 1 school banner 3 school banners = 1 school medallion

It will be the responsibility of the students and parents to keep all awards in a safe place so they can be sent in and registered for the next level award. The awards will be returned to the student.

Students who receive a school medallion prior to Year 6 will be able to restart the process to work towards a second medallion.

School ribbons will be presented at each fortnightly assembly. School Banners and Medallions will be presented at Week 9 and 10 assemblies each term. Parents are welcome to attend these assemblies each fortnight.

Students in Year 5 and 6 only have until the end of March to bring in any merit awards they have at home to receive the next level award. Kindergarten to Year 4 will only be able to use any merit awards received in 2018.
