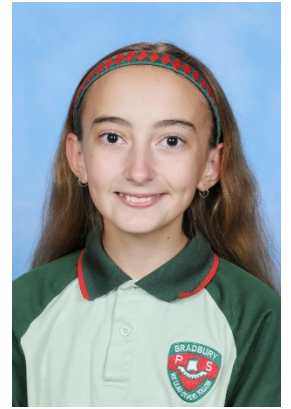

Aboriginal Student Awards

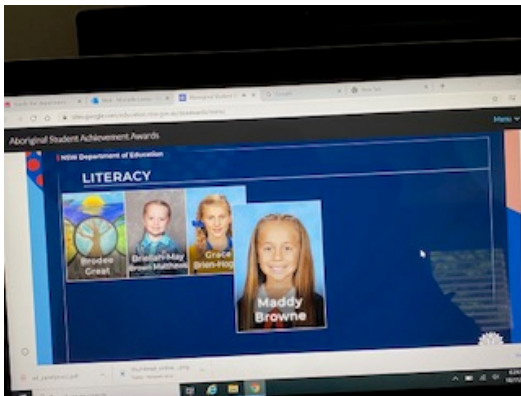
On Thursday 18 November a selected number of our students were successfully after being nominated by the school for the Aboriginal Student Achievement Awards.

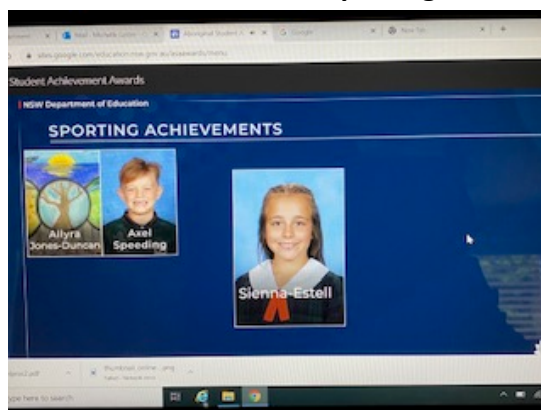
